We are very concerned about our British Citizens and residents who have Indefinite Leave to Remain in the UK and are stuck in India. We are continuously receiving phone calls from our members in New Delhi, Mumbai, Porbandar, Goa and various other cities and villages from Punjab about this serious issue. They went to India for a holiday or to see their family and friends and now are unable to return from India because of the Covid-19 outbreak.

Many of our members/British Citizens/UK Residents are currently suffering from high blood pressure, diabetes and other illnesses. Their prescribed medicine from their GP is now finished and money has run out. Some individuals have finished their cash but have some limit to use on their credit cards but at the Indian market they are unable to buy anything because most of the places do not have any facilities to use it. Many people are on full lockdown and they want to join their family in the UK as soon as possible.

We are aware of and welcome the foreign office to make an announcement to commit to £75million in order to bring home British Citizens and residents.


We would be very grateful if you could make to urgent attempt to fulfil this.

1. Please inform all our British Citizen and residents about the charter flights from India to the UK.

2. Our British Citizens and residents are under full lock down and unable to come to any port. Please make necessary safe arrangements with the cooperation of the Indian Govt to bring them to a port.
3. Please make arrangements with no hassle to our British Citizens whose Indian visa has expired.
4. Please make arrangements with the Indian authority to deliver relevant medicine to those who urgently require it.
